RECOMMENDATION:

The Administration recommends that the Board approve calendar proposal #1 as the 2007–08 school year calendar.

BACKGROUND:

Each year the District works with the employee associations and site administrators to develop a proposed calendar for the upcoming school year. This year three calendars were proposed and presented to CSEA, PGTA, and District Administration. The most popular calendar was the calendar most similar to the current calendar (breaks and holidays) only moving the dates forward. A second calendar option was created and brought forward to consider the high school's request of being able to have the first semester end prior to Winter Break that would allow finals to be scheduled prior to Winter Break. In this proposal, Fall Break was eliminated. The third calendar option was a compromise of the two calendars, keeping Fall Break and allowing for finals prior to Winter Break. In order to accomplish the third calendar, the most significant change was a much earlier start date. The following calendar is the focus of the current discussion. The calendar was developed in a joint meeting with CSEA, PGTA and District Administration.

INFORMATION:

The proposed calendar addresses the primary interest of the majority of our represented groups. School will start for students on August 22, 2007 and end on June 6, 2008.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Adoption of the calendar meets all State requirements for funding as students will be in class for 180 days as required and teachers will work 183 days except for new teachers who will work 184 days, consistent with current contract language. Therefore, there is no adverse fiscal impact resulting from the adoption of the calendar as proposed.
