OFFICIAL GED TEST

Applicants must be 18 years of age and have picture identification. Test can be taken in sections. Five Parts: Reading, Writing, Science, Social Studies, and Math. Advanced registration and \$125 payment required (\$20 per test for re-takes). Call (831)656-6506.
