

FUND-RAISING AT THE PG CO-OP PRESCHOOL

Currently we have two major fund raising projects; the Children's Winterfest, held in December, and a Spring Auction and Dance.

Children's Winterfest

For twenty six years we have held our Children's Winterfest. In the beginning we had a Children's Store only. Children came and shopped at very low prices, for handmade items for their family and friends. To fill a greater need we expanded our efforts and added a General Store where adults could shop, a few activity booths, a small silent auction, a raffle, and a kitchen area where guests could buy a light lunch or snack. We out grew our original location at the Preschool and moved to the Community Center, then to the multi purpose building at PG High School. In 1998 we moved to the Meals on Wheels building where we hope to hold the event again this year.

The goal of the Winterfest is threefold: to provide a community event for children where they can go to shop for gifts for their families and friends at low prices and to provide a safe, fun community event especially for school age children. In addition, we raise money that goes directly to the Preschool classroom and program. We want the Winterfest to be a full fun filled day that can be enjoyed by everyone involved.

Each family's responsibility in accomplishing this is:

- Work on a committee
- Sell raffle tickets
- Make items to be sold at the Winterfest
- Bake an item for the Bake Shop
- Work three hours the day of the Winterfest
- Help with setup or clean up
- Have Fun

The Winterfest is scheduled for the first Saturday of December.
