

## PG Co-op PreSchool: Parental Obligations Contract

By enrolling your child in the Pacific Grove Adult School Co-op Preschool, you have chosen to be a part of your child's educational process. Below is a list that you as a parent must be responsible for during the school year so that your child may attend the Preschool:

- I. Classroom Workdays—Each family is required to work one session per week in the classroom during your child's class time. If you have two children enrolled in the preschool, you must work two extra days per month at the school. Those days can be "floating" workdays or set workdays. We understand that in some cases a job outside the home makes it impossible for parents to work in the classroom. You may ask either a friend or relative to work for you or you may hire another co-op parent to work for you at a fee of \$25.00 per work day.
- II. Parent Meetings—Each family is required to attend two Tuesday night meetings per month. We will explain this in more detail at our first meeting.
- III. Winterfest—Each family is required to make items for the Children's Store, contribute one item for the bake shop, sell six books of raffle tickets, work at least three hours the day of the event, attend Tuesday night workshops and join a committee. We will talk more about the Winterfest at the parent meetings. Winterfest is held the first Saturday in December - SAVE THE DATE!
- IV. Spring Auction—Each family is required to contribute in the production of this event. Usually held in early May.
