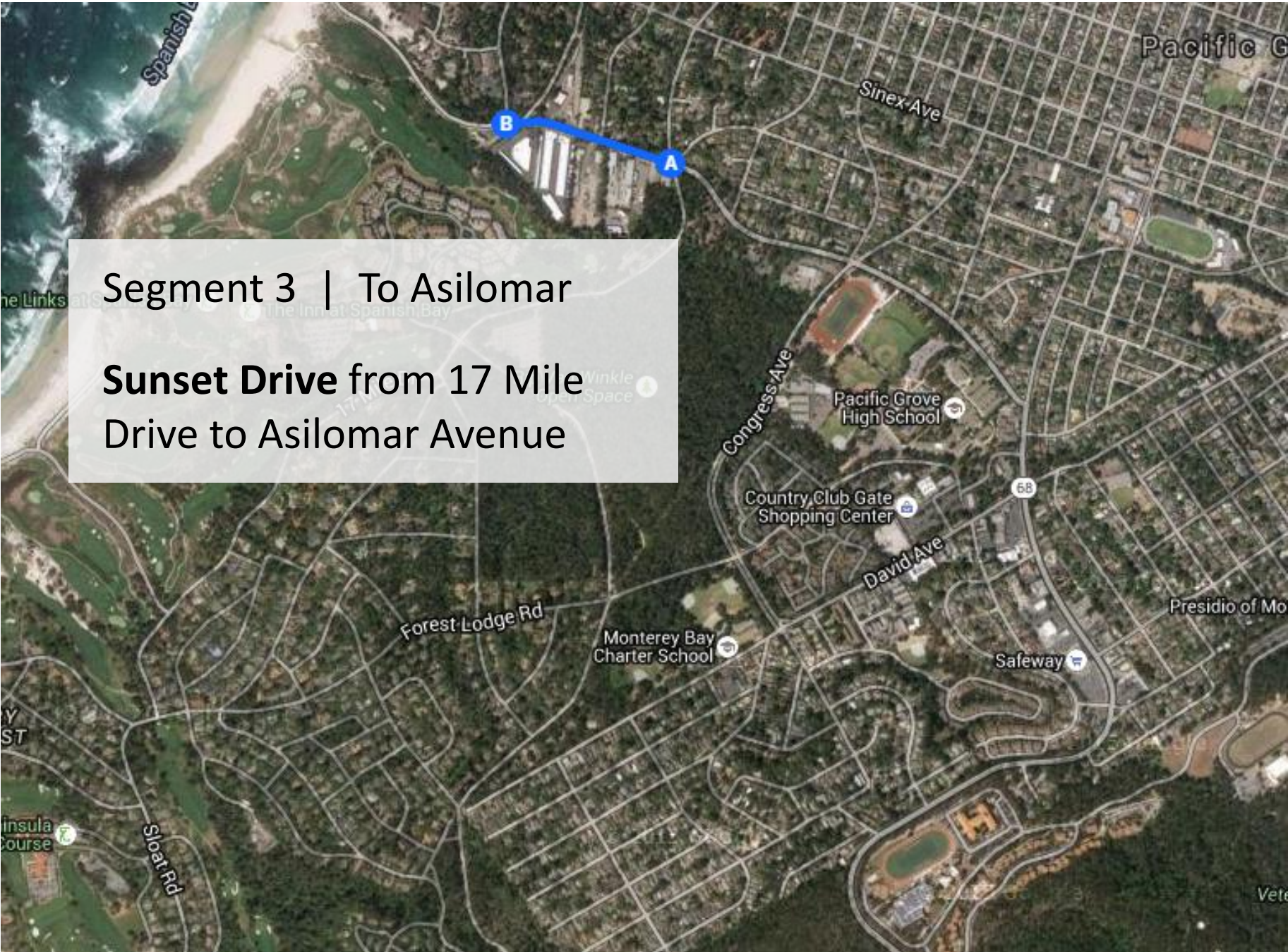

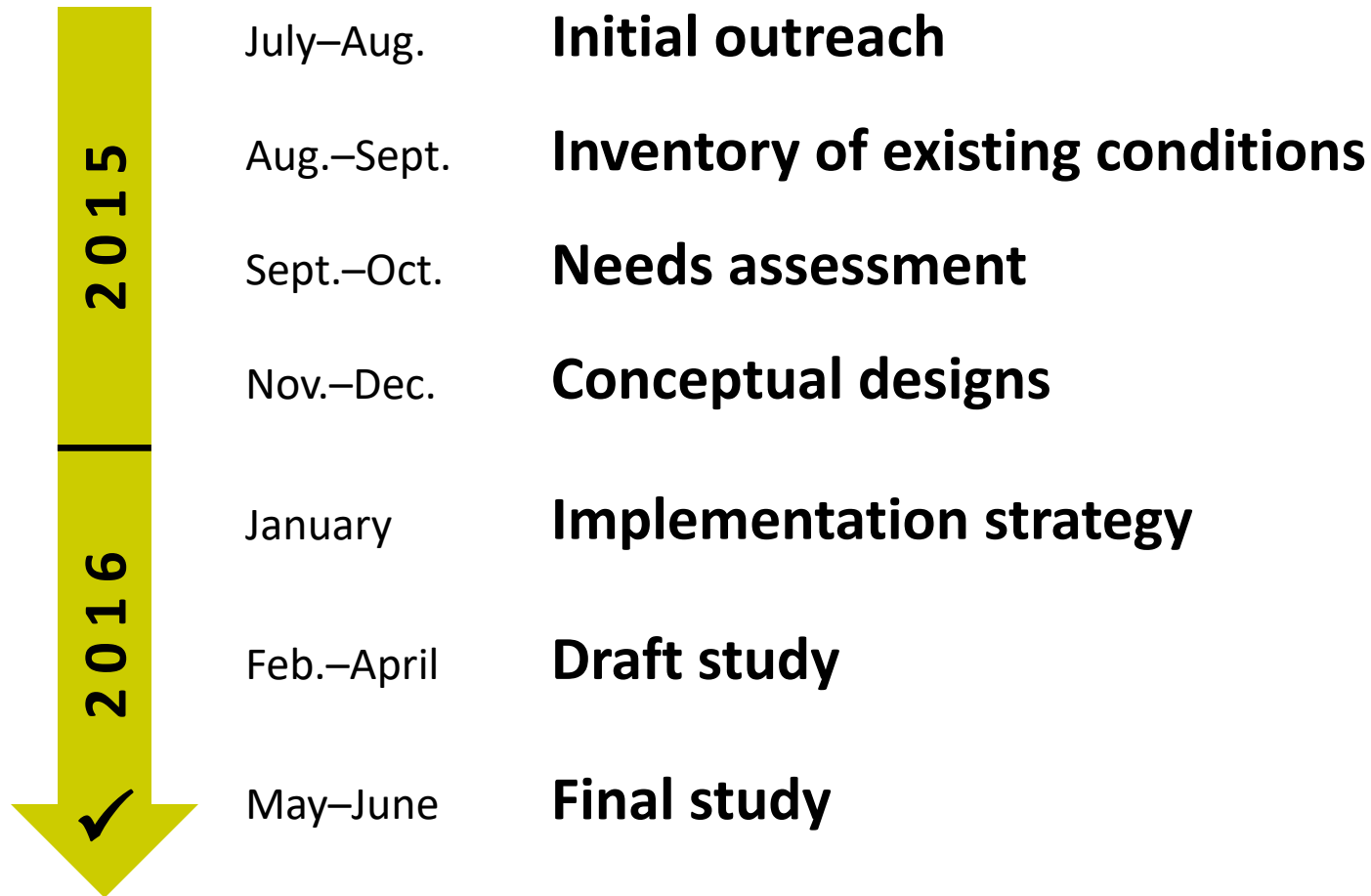




Segment 3 | To Asilomar
