- Update and align instructional technology in all classrooms



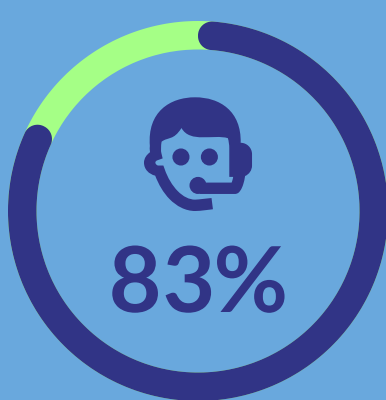
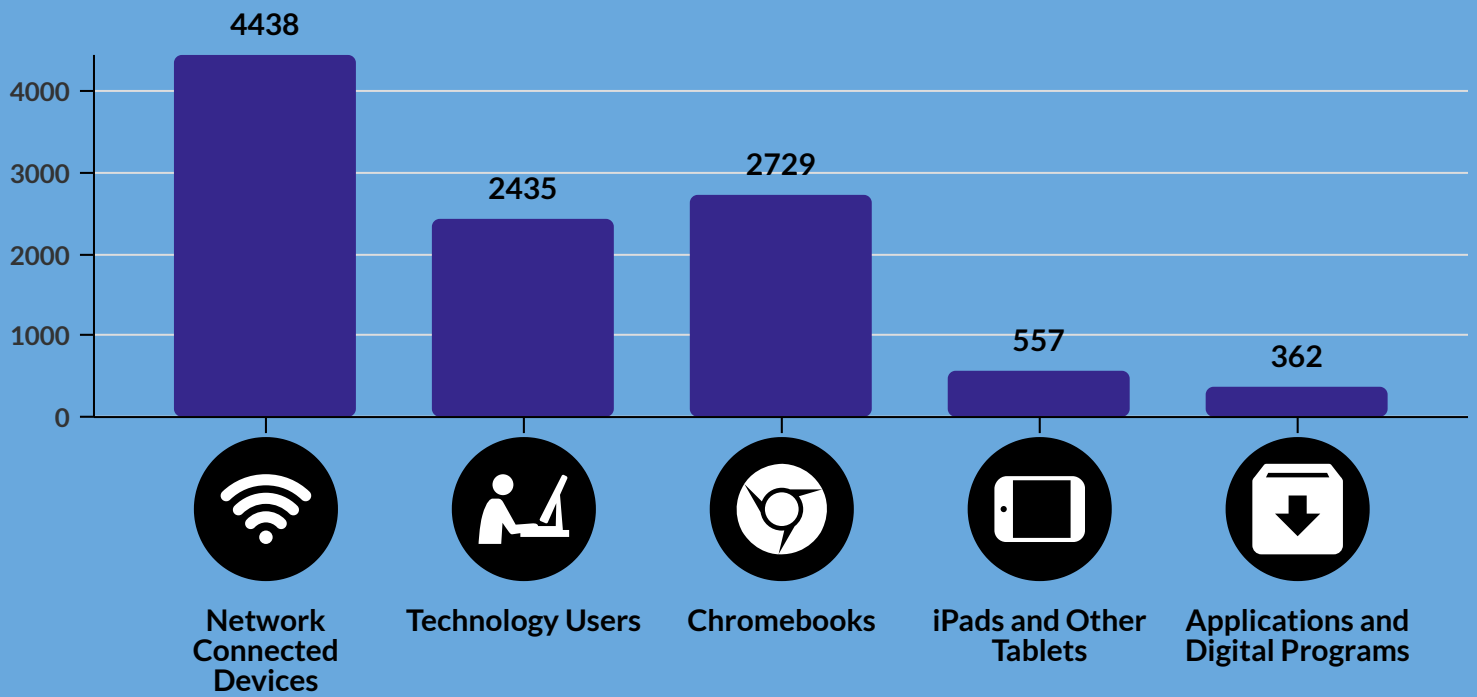

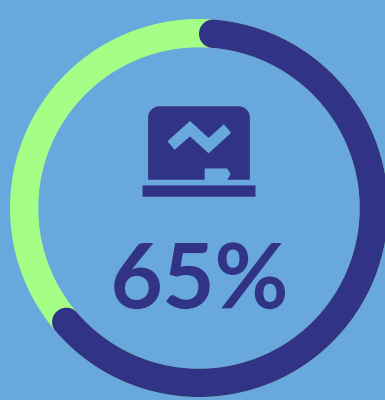
