

Percentages taking AP test and passing rate

- 82% of all students in each class take the exam.
- The average passing rate is (coincidentally) 82%.
- Some students do not take the exam because colleges will not accept them. E.g. Harvard, Yale, NYC do not accept Govt. <u>Either</u> lang or lit is accepted, not both, so students don't take both tests.



AP Test Scores (2017): PGHS vs. CA




AP course demographics


- Overall AP student enrollment closely resembles general student demographic at PGHS.
