SUBJECT: REVISED Contract for Substitute Speech Therapists

PERSON(S) RESPONSIBLE: Clare Davies, Director of Student Services

RECOMMENDATION:

The District Administration recommends that the Board review and approve two contracts to provide interim substitute Speech and Language Therapists while the district continues recruitment efforts for a contracted Speech Therapist. These positions will no longer be required once a contracted speech therapist has been hired (Consent Item K).

BACKGROUND:

The School District is required to provide Speech and Language services for students on IEPs. Despite ongoing recruitment efforts, the district has not been able to fill the Speech Therapist vacancy that serves students at PGMS and PGHS.

INFORMATION:

Student Services has identified two retired Speech Therapists who are willing to serve as interim substitute therapists during the time the district works to identify a candidate to fill the vacancy at PGMS and PGHS. The two therapists commit to serving two days a week each (totaling four days a week) to provide services and case-management for the .80 vacancy. The interim substitute therapists will fill this vacancy until the time the district identifies a contracted therapist through a non public agency.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The two interim substitute Speech Therapists will work;

7.0 hours a day, 2 days a week, at \$100 an hour, totaling \$1,400 a week each.

Total cost is \$2,800 a week.

Cost to be offset by budgeted amount for a .80 district employee \$77,983

- (1) There is a specifically <u>documented cost savings</u> relative to using district employment. (The documentation requirements are specified and must be attached).
- (2) The contract is for new school district functions and the <u>Legislature has specifically mandated or authorized</u> the performance of the work by independent contractors.

The method of selection and the qualification standards for an emergency employee shall be determined by the district. The frequency of appointment, length of employment, and the circumstances appropriate for the appointment of firms or individuals under emergency appointments shall be restricted so as to prevent the use of emergency appointments to circumvent the regular or ordinary hiring process.
